Sandford Station Railway Heritage Ltd. was formed in 2009 to set up and run the Railway Heritage Centre in the former Sandford Station ticket office building now the iconic centre of Sandford Station Retirement Village owned by the St Monica Trust. This early Bristol and Exeter Grade II listed building of 1869 is an architectural gem and one of the best examples of its kind. It has been carefully restored to former glory.

The building provides an authentic venue in which to tell the story of the station and railway, past to present. Sandford Quarry had its own siding into the station and was an important large-scale operation and employer in the area. We have been fortunate in rescuing and restoring a 1948 Sentinel engine from the quarry. Also on static display alongside the platform is a 1950s MK1 carriage and railway trucks. The Centre is designed to be attractive to all visitors, but particularly to families visiting from the adjoining Strawberry Line path. It has much to interest railway enthusiasts and also provides an educational resource.

We would welcome new stewards to meet visitors at weekends or help with teas etc.. Our Gauge 1 model railway layout is now 'go' and we would be pleased to hear from anyone willing to help with running days or who would like to hear more. The group is always seeking genuine artefacts and carries out research.
